House Call - Material and preparation list

Comfortable clothing is ideal for the house call, preferably a smock or an old shirt that can get dirty. For the first exercises, a cozy spot at the dining table or a clipboard, along with soft pencils (at least HB) and A4 paper, will suffice. When painting on A2 paper (approximately 60 x 40 cm), ample space should be available. Tables can be covered with fabric or paper for protection if desired. Acrylic paint is water-soluble and can be easily removed while wet.

There are several options for painting positions:

- At the Table: Sitting or standing, with the paper directly on the table.
- In Front of an Upside-Down Chair: The paper is fixed to a wooden board held between the chair legs.
- At an Easel: The paper and wooden board can be used, or alternatively, a canvas.
- On the Floor: Sitting, squatting, or standing, with the paper on a solid surface (a canvas can also be used here).
- Standing: The painting surface is fixed to the wall.

*Corresponding boards can be brought by Tina upon request.

Sustainability Welcome:

Feel free to use any materials you already have!

For cleaning brushes, empty jam jars or similar containers, as well as cleaning rags (old towels, T-shirts, or cotton scraps), work excellently. Soap for cleaning your hands is sufficient, and some hand cream for care is recommended. Acrylic paint and brushes should include primary colors (Red, Yellow, Blue) and White; specific details can be found in the list below. During the session, everyone will paint more than just one picture – thus, using canvases is optional.

Material-Liste

1. Hard and protective surfaces, water containers, and cleaning rags for preparation.

2. HB – 3B pencils, approx. €1 per participant: at least 1 each.

3. Sharpener and eraser: One each for the group or more if available.

4. A4 white paper, regular typing paper or similar: At least 5 sheets per participant.

- Alternatively, a sketch pad A4 (21 x 29.7 cm), 190 g/m², 50 sheets, approx. €7.

- For 1 – 8 participants: 1 x; for 9 – 12 participants: 2 x.

5. A2 sketch pad (42 cm x 59.4 cm), 190 g/m², 50 sheets, approx. €20.

- For 1 – 8 participants: 1 x; for 9 – 12 participants: 2 x.

6. Charcoal sticks, medium thickness (approx. 4 – 6 mm), one pack of 25 pieces, approx. €5.

7. Masking tape, at least 19 mm wide: One roll of 50 m, approx. €2.50.

- For 1 – 8 participants: 1 x; for 9 – 12 participants: 2 x.

8. Acrylic brushes, sizes from 5 mm to 10 cm: At least one brush per participant from €2.

- Recommendation: „Cat’s tongue“ shape in three different sizes (5 mm, 16 mm, and 33 mm) plus one flat brush (60 mm / 6 cm).

9. Acrylic paints in primary colors and white: Bottle of 500 ml for €15 – €30.

- For 1 – 8 participants: one bottle per color; for 9 – 12 participants: two bottles per color:

- **Yellow:** Lemon Yellow or Cadmium Yellow (imit.)

- **Red:** True Red or Primary Magenta

- **Blue:** Ultramarine Blue or Cobalt Blue

- **White:** Titanium White

Check-Liste

- **Comfortable Clothing:** Wear a smock or an old shirt that can get dirty.
- **Pencils:** Soft pencils (at least HB).
- **Eraser and Sharpener:** At least one each for the group.
- **Paper:** A4 and A2
- **Space Requirement:** Each participant needs enough space for painting on approximately 60 x 40 cm.
- **Surface:** A wooden board plus an upside-down chair on the table or floor (easel if available).
- **Attachment:** The sheets of paper will be attached to wooden boards with masking tape.
- **Bring Along:** Bring your acrylic paints and brushes.
- **Important!** Primary colors (Red, Yellow, Blue) and White.
- **Cleaning Materials:** Empty jam jars or similar containers; cleaning rags (old towels, T-shirts); soap; hand cream.
- **Canvases:** Using canvases is optional.
- **ackaging:** Finished pictures should be stored in a folder or rolled up with masking tape/rubber bands (optionally in a large plastic bag or cardboard tube).
- **Existing Materials:** Compare your existing pencils, brushes, paper, and colors with the list.
- **Ordering:** Everything else can be ordered online; suitable links are provided in the list.
- **Consultation:** Alternatively, you can consult directly in-store.
